

【4】次の英文は、Harutoが授業で食品ロス(food loss)について発表するために書いた原稿です。これを読んで、あとの問いに答えなさい。

Good morning. Today, I'd like to talk about food loss. Have you heard about food loss? I think many of you have heard of it, but you may not know much about it. So I want you to learn more about this problem through my presentation.

Food loss means *wasting food that we can still eat. Many people know *throwing away food is not good, but I guess they don't think that this is a big problem because there is a lot of food around us. At first, I wasn't interested in this problem. However, my father told me that there are about 8 hundred million hungry people in the world, even though over 1.3 billion *tons of food is thrown away every year. I wanted to know the situation about the food loss in Japan and tried to get more information. Then, I found a good website on the Internet. It shows that in Japan in one year, about 6 million tons of *edible food is thrown away, and about half of it comes from homes. I couldn't believe it. Also, I learned that throwing away food means wasting the water and energy used to make the food, and if we *burn *food waste, it makes CO₂. Wasting food is bad for the environment, too.

Let's think why people waste so much food. For example, in a supermarket, people sometimes buy too much food, and forget to eat it. Then it becomes food waste. In a restaurant or at home, people sometimes order or cook too much food, so they can't eat all of it. Also, some people want to buy *fruits or vegetables which look good. So, some fruits and vegetables are thrown away just because of the color or shape.

Well, what can we do to stop food loss? First, we can stop buying too much food. Before going shopping, we should check []. Second, we can stop ordering or cooking too much food. Then we can eat everything and we won't waste food. Third, we can give food to *food banks. Do you know about food banks? Food banks collect the food which is not sold or eaten. Then they give it to people who don't have enough food. So, if we have too much food, we can help people by sending it to food banks without wasting food.

I believe we all can do something to solve problems and help people. I think it is important to start with small things that we can do in our daily lives. One small thing I can do to stop food loss is to give food to food banks. How about you? Let's do something small for a better life. Thank you for listening.
